Finished in ex-bourbon casks: butterscotch, Heath-bar, toffee and cocoa.

Michter's, 10 yr, Straight Rye, Kentucky - 92.8 Proof
Spicey Rye, candied orange peepl, angel food cake, banana peel and smoke.

Sazerac Barrel Proof Rye, "Thomas H. Handy," Kentucky - 126.2 Proof
Powerful, lush, and boldly spicy. Flavors of toffee, fig cake, cinnamon and coconut.
