The rarest Bourbon and American Whiskeys to be found.

George Dickel, 17yr, Tennessee Whiskey, Tennessee - 87 Proof	39.
Bright red cherry, nectarine, mature oak, and salted butter.	
Eagle Rare, 17yr, Kentucky - 90 Proof	42.
Only 32 barrels made for the world; the aromas are almost wine like, almond, cigar, and leather.	
Elijah Craig, 18yr, "Single Barrel," Kentucky - 90 Proof	40.
Deep leather, mint, chocolate, mocha and honey.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Rhetoric 20 yr," Kentucky - 90. Proof	30.
Dark and tropical fruits, baking spices and vanilla.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Rhetoric 21 yr," Kentucky - 90. Proof	32.
Oak and vanilla nose with banana, clove, star anise and spiced finish.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Rhetoric 22 yr," Kentucky - 90. Proof	34.
The 22 yr shows more complex oak, toffee, bananas and developed barrel spice.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Barterhouse 20 yr," Kentucky - 90. Proof	37.
Orphan's first release. Aged barrel, caramel, candied orange peel, and walnuts.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Lost Prophet 22 yr," Kentucky - 90. Proof	40.
Sweet banana bread, vanilla and cinamon, tart apple, leather and espresso.	
Woodford Reserve, "Master's Collection," Kentucky - 90.4 Proof	23.
Finished in Brandy casks almost 2 years. Dry cherry, hazelnut, intense vanilla.	
Jim Beam, "Distiller's Masterpiece," Kentucky - 100 Proof	44.
Finished in PX Sherry casks. Dried dark fruits, nuts, licorice and marmalade.	
Old Rip Van Winkle, 10 yr, Kentucky - 107. Proof	35.
Peppery brown spices, floral honey and charred barrel.	
Four Roses, "Elliot's Selection 2016 Limited Edition," Barrel Strength, Kentucky - 108 Proof	37.
Rich peach and apricot, toffee, ginger, and vanilla.	
Jefferson's, "Ocean Aged," Cask Strength, Kentucky - 112 Proof	23.
Fully mellowed by its four trips around the world. Leather, caramel, sea salt, cinnamon.	
Orphan Barrel Project, "Gifted Horse," American Whiskey, Kentucky - 116 Proof	18.
Technically a Bourbon and Rye Whiskey. Spicy with caramel, toasted oak and fennel seed.	
Angel's Envy, "Cask Strength," Kentucky - 127.9 Proof	45.
Cherry, chocolate covered almonds and a sweet barrel finish.	
William Larue Weller, "Barrel Proof," Kentucky - 135.4 Proof	50.
Tones of toasted marshmallow, salted almonds, nougat, figs, and dates.	
George T. Stagg, "Barrel Proof," Kentucky - 144.1 Proof	47.
Underlying notes of dates, tobacco, dark berries, and a hint of coffee.	



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♠ AMERICAN RYE

Some of the finest North American Rye Whiskeys, period.

- Sazerac, 18 yr, Kentucky - 90 Proof** 45.
Very mature, with notes of oak, leather molasses and all-spice. Finishing with big sweet vanilla.
- WhistlePig, "Old Estate Oak," 15 yr, Vermont - 92 Proof** 34.
Finished in ex-bourbon casks: butterscotch, Heath-bar, toffee and cocoa.
- Michter's, 10 yr, Straight Rye, Kentucky - 92.8 Proof** 26.
Spicy Rye, candied orange peopl, angel food cake, banana peel and smoke.
- Thomas H. Handy, Sazerac, "Barrel Proof," Kentucky - 126.2 Proof** 45.
Powerful, lush, and boldly spicy. Flavors of toffee, fig cake, cinnamon and coconut.

The finest Spirits from around the globe.

- Tesseron, "Lot 90," X.O., Cognac, France - 86 Proof** 22.
Fresh pear and apple, light on its feet with honeyed tones and candied oranges.
- Delord, 25 yr, Bas-Armagnac, France - 80 Proof** 25.
Complex sweet fig, toffee, caramel and leathery spice.
- 1975 Château Laubade, "Cask Strength," Armagnac, France - 88.4 Proof** 45.
Delicate and developed sweet red cherry tones, plum, candied almond and baking spice.
- 1986 Château Laubade, "Cask Strength," Armagnac, France - 97 Proof** 38.
Bold spice, dried figs and plums with hints of marzipan.
- Macallan, 18 yr, Single Malt Whiskey, Speyside, Scotland - 86 Proof** 35.
The most awarded Scotch of all time. Dried fruits, ginger, chocolate, orange and big Sherry.
- 1997 Samaroli, "Isle of Jura," Single Malt Whiskey, Jura, Scotland - 90 Proof** 30.
Raw honey, green apple, red fruits, brine and a heavy vanilla finish.
- Kavalan, "Ex-Bourbon Cask," Single Malt Whiskey, Taiwan - 118.8 Proof** 30.
Unmistakably elegant tropical fruits, vanilla bean and sweet spices.
- Chartreuse, "Green V.E.P," Liqueur, France - 108 Proof** 28.
A Medium-sweet palate of mint, citrus, fennel, sage and crushed herbs.
