#### MV Roederer Estate Sparkling Brut - 6 (2oz) / 15 (5oz)

*Anderson Valley – California*

The French influence from sister winery Domaine Louis Roederer in Champagne is undeniable. Refined bubbles are the first thing you notice, then the rich pear, red apples, and brioche toast from extended bottle aging. Each glass is proof that California can compete with the best in the world.

### How Sweet It Is

#### MV Malvira Birbet, Brachetto, Sparkling Rosso - 5 (2oz) / 11 (5oz)

*Piedmont–Italy*

Offering tart lime, lemon and green-plum flavors offset by a glaze of honeycomb. It's a laser-edged penetrating wine finishing on a reverberating mineral tone.

### Rose'

#### 2019 Scribe, "Estate," Rose' - 6 (2oz) / 14 (5oz)

*Sonoma Valley*

From the Scribe Estate on the south west-facing slope of Arrowhead Mountain. Clones Mount Eden, Martini, Pommard planted on rootstock in a combination of volcanic tuff and Huichica loam soils. Peach Blossom, Yuzu, Wild Strawberry.

*Uruguay*

For context, Uruguay’s SE coast is parallel with Argentina’s famed Mendoza appellation.

Only a few producers are experimenting with the Albariño variety. Grapefruit, apples and wild flowers shine in this cool-climate coastal bottling.

**2018 Laird, “Cold Creek Ranch,” Pinot Grigio - 4.5 (2oz) / 11 (5oz)**

*Carneros – Napa*

Ken Laird’s Cold Creek vineyard in Carneros, with its proximity close to the bay, ensures crisp acidity and classic pear, white nectarines and green apples. Across the board, these well made wines deliver value at every turn.

### White Wines - Fruity & Aromatic

**2019 Emmolo, Sauvignon Blanc - 5 (2oz) / 12 (5oz)**

*Napa - California*

Jenny Wagner’s grandparents, the Emmolo’s, started growing grapes in Napa in the 1920’s. The Wagner side of the family started Caymus Estate. With grapes coming from two family owned vineyards, this wine boasts clean minerality and delicate fruit flavor

**2018 Frog’s Leap, “Shale and Stone,” Chardonnay - 6 (2oz) / 14 (5oz)**

*Napa – California*

A Rutherford institution for organic farming and sustainability, and one of the coolest winery stories we know (motorcycles were sold to fund the first vintage in 1980). Balanced between rich apple and pear fruits and freshness from minimal oak, this Chardonnay impresses.

Made using declassified fruit from Chablis and Puligny-Montrachet, this phenomenal wine exhibits aromas of crisp pear, lemon zest and minerals. Fresh and lively with a silky texture. An absolute steal for the price!

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### Reds - Elegant & Aromatic

**2014 Dolin, “La Encantada,” Pinot Noir - 5 (2oz) / 12 (5oz)**

*Santa Rita Hills – California*

Oenologist Alberto Antonini makes this classical Rosso (young-vine Brunello) from impeccable Sangiovese vines. Bright red and black cherries, anise, red plum, minerals and earth make a complete and complex Sangio from this tiny estate.

**2018 Hanzell, “Sebella,” Pinot Noir - 7 (2oz) / 16 (5oz)**

*Santa Rita Hills – California*

The ‘Sebella’ Pinot Noir is comprised of excellent Sonoma Coast fruit at a super-affordable price. The wine mirrors the age-worthy wines of the Hanzell estate. Fresh fruit characteristics and charm aptly describes the Sebella.

### Reds - Fruit Forward

**2017 Renwood, “Premier Old Vine,” Zinfandel - 4.5 (2oz) / 11 (5oz)**

*Amador - California*

A pioneer producer from ol’ gold country. Renwood uses historic old Zin vineyards to extract flavors of strawberry, chocolate and anise. The vines vary from 50 to 103 years of age!

**2016 Hoopla, “Reserve,” Cabernet Sauvignon - 5.5 (2oz) / 13 (5oz)**

*California*

This wine’s dense, dark garnet hue beckons you to dive deep into the nose as it opens with hints of Peruvian peppercorn, Raspberry, bramble, and graphite.

**Barrell Craft Spirits 13 yr, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection,” Rye - Canada, 126 Proof - 24**

Rich spicy notes are framed by sweet oak, vanilla and a hint of caramel. You’re going to fall in love with its complexity and versatility.

**Elijah Craig, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection” Bourbon - Kentucky, 94 Proof - 12**

Aromas of caramel and buttercream are balanced by hints of oak and red fruits through the palate.

**FEW, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection,” Rye - Illinois, 117 Proof - 17**

This is a spice bomb, in all the right ways! Cinnamon, clove, nutmeg... all your classic winter spices accented by beautiful, sweet overtones.

**Four Roses, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection,” Bourbon - Kentucky, 110 Proof - 17**

a diverse array of flavors on the palate including vanilla, warming oak spice, tropical fruit and a hint of caramel. The finish is where the herbal tones arrive, with a minty freshness balanced by baking spices

A beautifully layered straight bourbon with notes of fleshy nectarines, Marzipan, caramel and freshly snapped vanilla bean. A rounded soul-warming treat for the bourbon lover.

**Maker’s Mark, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection #5,” Bourbon - Kentucky, 108 Proof - 18**

We went heavy on the French oak this time and it give this whisky an unmistakable elegance with notes of caramel, toasted spice, a hint of vanilla and dried fruits.

**Old Potrero, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection,” Rye - California, 111 Proof - 21**

Youthful and bright nose with waves of decadent spice interlaced with aromas of dark red berries, and a distinct plummy notes. Finished in Wine Barrels.

**Russell’s Reserve, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection #7,” Bourbon - Kentucky, 110 Proof - 14**

Robust aromas of caramel, spice and oak lead to a palate that hits all the right notes.

**Spirit Works, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection Port Cask,” Rye - Sebastopol, 110 Proof - 12**

A true small-batch, high-rye whiskey. Aromas of bright, tart green apple giving way to autumnal notes of baked apple and coffee, followed by a woody aroma of cedar and leather. Peppery hints of clove and nutmeg enliven an alluring blend of caramel, vanilla, and toasted coconut on the palate.

**WhistlePig 10yr, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection #2612,” Rye - Vermont, 116.9 Proof - 20**

Back by popular demand! The palate is bold, with backing notes of maple syrup, Boston cream pie and a hint of lingering cinnamon-dusted cheesecake.

**Woodinville, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection #1998,” Bourbon - Washington, 122.4 Proof - 16**

aromas of freshly snapped vanilla bean, ripe red fruits, and leading to a palate accented by toasted oak; all laced with caramel and toffee.

**Wild Turkey, “Bounty Hunter Private Selection #3,” Bourbon - Kentucky, 101 Proof - 14**

Hints of dried fruit, bananas Foster, and crème brulee lead the charge, backed by touches of oak spice, barrel char and a whiff of toasted coconut.
